One half of Troy London's sister duo, Rosie Van Cutsem told Vogue, "the idea of a creative collaboration first came about last year, when the pandemic had driven tourism to a standstill and India was at the epicentre of the global Covid 19 outbreak. We were keen to support and raise awareness of the critical conservation work of SUJÁN, (in its 21st anniversary year) not to mention the 20,000 villagers who benefit from their luxury tented camps, whilst also creating something that would appeal to

And so the 100% cotton drill Tracker Jacket—all Troy London garments are crafted and manufactured in the UK, including working with local seamstresses, leathersmiths, waterproof experts—was re-envisioned with a beautiful inner finished in a rich contrast binding in scarlet red, inspired by the traditional turbans of the Rabari tribe that roam the Jawai wilderness. The utilitarian pockets omnipresent on any safari jacket were fastened with monogrammed bone buttons. Reflecting the easy synergy of the partnership, the Troy London X SUJÁN Special Edition Tracker Jacket works best thrown on for a summer morning in the Rajasthan wilderness or layered over light knitwear for an <u>autumn</u> countryside walk in England.
