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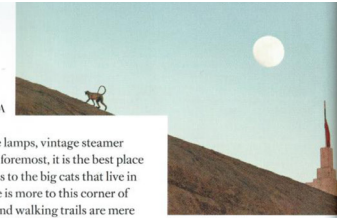
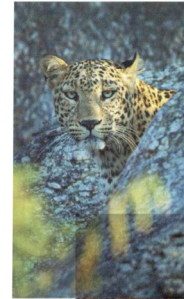
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## GOING WILD

### B Jawai RAJASTHAN, INDIA

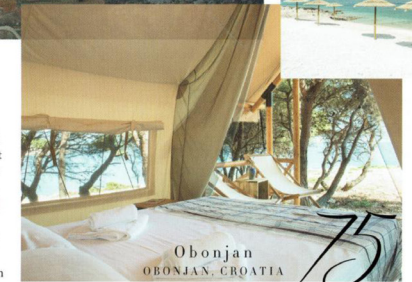
Jawai is gorgeous, with romantic silver hurricane lamps, vintage steamer trunks and burnished steel and leather. But first and foremost, it is the best place in India to see wild leopards, with unfettered access to the big cats that live in rocky outcrops alongside busy villages. And there is more to this corner of Rajasthan than leopards: fabulous bird-watching and walking trails are mere steps from your tent, and you can embark on a dawn trek, when you might see eagle owls, a flock of flamingos or even a crocodile.

A hidden private-island oasis of pine- and olive-trees, Obonjan gives guests the chance to reconnect with nature and rediscover themselves. Summers here are a showcase of great music, food and art; plus, you can stargaze with the resident astronomer or try crystal-healing. Spacious bell tents are available for one to three people, and feature comfortable beds, chic furnishings and air-conditioning, or you can opt to stay in an ensuite Forest Lodge with uninterrupted views of the sea. You'll fall in love with island living, but Wi-Fi is available should you wish.
